Vender Security Information

In an effort to ensure everyone's safety for Hamvention, Security is asking for assistance in monitoring the crowd for potentially dangerous persons looking to inflict harm. We are simply asking for you to report the following to event staff and Police:

- **Suspicious persons:** This could include persons seeking information about security cameras, police response, accessing restricted areas or tampering with fire suppression equipment.
- **Suspicious packages:** Items being left behind for no apparent reason. Hamvention is a unique event that presents a great deal of difficulty in determining suspicious packages. Ask yourself what is normal for the event and what is not.
- **Individual's overheard making threats of any kind.**
- **Anyone, other than law enforcement personnel, possessing a firearm.**

These are just a few examples of this suspicious activity. Keep in mind that if it makes you uncomfortable or brings question to your senses, you are better off reporting it.

Vendors are to monitor their own equipment and packaging. Be sure to keep aisle ways clear of boxes and other packaging. This allows potentially dangerous/suspicious items to be located quicker. If items are located you may be questioned and asked to stow the equipment elsewhere.

In order to address any complaints in a timelier manner, report activity to event staff with a radio so that it can be broadcast and the proper response can be determined.

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
